NEWS FROM FORMER PARISHIONER MOTHER ANNA (Mother Helena at All Saints). St. Barbara Monastery in Santa Paula, CA, near LA, has grown from 8 to 15 monastics over the past few years, with another 5 women waiting to try monastic life there. Having run out of cells, they were using RV's to house sisters and guests. Last week, the County told them they have to remove the RV's. Since historic Holy Assumption Monastery, in Calistoga, CA, is empty except for the hieromonk who has been renovating it since 1998, it seems to be the answer to prayers. Holy Assumption, located two hours plus northeast of San Francisco, was started in 1941 by nuns who had escaped Russia and China with St. John Maximovitch. The last nuns moved away in the late 1980's due to ill health. This week, ten of the sisters, *including Mother Anna*, will move in there. Mother Anna says that as an Anglican nun, she was known as the "moveable" one! She assures us that All Saints is always in her prayers and asks for our prayers for the monastery.
