**THE IMAGE OF CHRIST NOT-MADE-WITH-HANDS** (the Holy Face) was put up as an emblem of the Russian armies, defending them from the enemy; and in the Russian Orthodox Church there is a pious custom that before entering a church, the faithful read together the prayers and the Troparion to the Image Not-Made-By-Hands.

Troparion (Tone 2) We venerate Thy most pure image, O Good One, and ask forgiveness of our transgressions, O Christ God. Of Thine own will Thou wast pleased to ascend the Cross in the flesh to deliver Thy creatures from bondage to the Enemy. Therefore with thanksgiving we cry aloud to Thee: "Thou hast filled all with joy, O our Savior, by coming to save the world."
