THE AKATHISTOS HYMN is the most famous Byzantine hymn to the Virgin Mary. Devotion to the Mother of God became central to the Identity of Constantinople in the sixth century, when she was taken as the protector of the city.

On the Fifth Saturday of Great Lent, the Saturday of the Akathist, we commemorate the "Laudation of the Virgin" Icon of the Most Holy Theotokos. The feastday was established to commemorate the victories of 625, 655 and 705 when the Theotokos protected the city from first Persian & then twice from Saracen invaders.
