HUNDREDS OF ORTHODOX CHRISTIAN PILGRIMS are expected to flock to Spruce Island, AK tomorrow, Monday, August 9, 2010, to celebrate the **40th anniversary of the canonization of Saint Herman of Alaska**, one of the first – and surely the most beloved – Orthodox Christian missionaries to serve the people of Alaska. A monk of Valaam Monastery in Russian Karelia, Saint Herman came to Alaska in 1794 to serve the native Alutiiq people and Russian fur traders. A tireless laborer as a simple un-ordained monk, Saint Herman established the Orthodox Church in Kodiak, defended the people against arguably outrageous treatment by Russian colonial officials, and cared for orphaned children on Spruce Island. He lived out the last 30 years of his life on Spruce Island as a hermit. At his death, a column of light was seen throughout the region rising from the forest to the heavens. Saint Herman of Alaska was glorified by the Church on August 9, 1970 and is universally recognized as a saint of the Orthodox Church and the protector of the Church in North America.

PARISH FINANCIAL REPORT: YTD THROUGH JULY, 2010

FINANCIAL MID-YEAR REPORT.

Although expenses have slightly decreased from previous years, the July 31st year-to-date operating shortfall is -\$4884.70. This budget deficit is due to a decrease in expected tithe revenue. Since building fund donations have totaled \$6403.17 to date, we have the potential to balance the operating budget if slightly less donations are restricted to the building fund (and are instead general tithe contributions). Excess operating funds can always be transferred to the building fund, but not vice-versa. For questions or a copy of July's financial reports please talk to our treasurer **John Teifel**.
