- **OCA NATIONAL CONTRIBUTIONS (ASSESSMENT)** All Saints is moving from a \$105. per member head tax to a flat 3% of income beginning in August. However our 2009 budget projected \$3500 in special OCA \$105.00 assessment donations from members, to cover the \$5,000 we expected to pay. Since we paid \$586. each month in assessments for the first seven months of the year based on the head tax, we still need some help to cover that expense. If you normally paid a separate donation for the OCA National Assessment and you are able, we ask you to please either add that additional \$105 into your regular tithe or consider making it as a separate donation so that we can make sure we do not suffer a budget shortfall.
